"If we make abortion illegal, women will have to have back alley abortions and some women will die."

### **Common Ground:**

I've heard the horror stories too, so I understand the concern. However...

- She doesn't *have to have* an abortion. No woman *is forced* to have one.
- Your reasoning is the same as saying murder should be legalized because people will do it anyway.
- There is no hard evidence of coat hanger abortions. In fact, a Planned Parenthood Medical Director reported 90% of illegal abortions were done by doctors.

"Abortion helps prevent over population."

### **Common Ground:**

Concern about overpopulation is common, however, did you know that...

- World population is either holding steady or declining? In fact, in the U.S., with a birth every 8 seconds and a death every 13 seconds, population is growing at less than 1%.
- I hope you agree that taking a life to make it more comfortable for those already born is a pretty selfish act.
- If you're talking about overcrowding that's a problem that should be solved by city planners, not population control.


